

Additonal Entrance Gates Notes for Bucket collectors

Thank you for being a Volunteer at Redbourn Classics. The whole event is organised and run by volunteers, so we really appreciate your help to make this such a great show and special village day.

- We have a suggested donation of £3 per adult, and free entry for under 16s. This is a donation because we cannot charge an entry fee on common land. Most people are happy to support, and many give more. Monies raised go to the local Redbourn charities we support.
 - Each public entrance will have 2 buckets and one Sum Up contactless payment terminal.
 - Signage will direct the public in 2 queues to the 2 tables at your gazebo. Each table has a bucket to accept cash donations, and one table also has the Sum Up machine.
 - The Sum Up machine must stay connected to the external battery as it will run out of internal battery under heavy use.
 - Please give stickers to donors and a copy of the flyer so that they can choose their favourite classic vehicle – these votes should be handed into Redbourn Auto Solutions near the stage by 3.30pm. Presentation of the prizes is at 4pm on the stage.
 - A map is supplied at your entrance gate so you can answer queries and direct people to the toilets, to the first aid station next to the stage and to any of the 40+ stalls. A map is also on the reverse side of your volunteer ID badge showing key locations.
 - Please stay at the gate until the next volunteers have arrived with their buckets to take over from you.
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- **At the end of your shift, the Sum Up machine and the stickers stay at the gate.**
 - **Please show the next volunteers how to use the Sum Up machine.**
 - **Buckets must be returned to Control Point at end of each shift along with hi-viz jackets & ID lanyards, where you can collect a voucher for some free refreshments at the Tea Tent as a thank you for your help.**
